SUBJECT: Low Income Day Care Funding

Several Commissioners have recently inquired about continued State funding of Low Income Day Care in State Fiscal Year 1990-91. We recognize that in a number of districts, local appropriations for this program expire on March 31 and that their county legislative bodies will need to take action to provide additional appropriations prior to this date in order to continue program operations after March 31. The purpose of this memorandum is to provide you with current information that may be helpful to you in obtaining new appropriations for 1990-91.

As you may know, Governor Cuomo has recommended continued funding of the Low Income Day Care Program in his proposed State Budget for 1990-1991. The amount requested is intended to preserve program operations at its current level. Subject to approval of the Governor's Budget by the State Legislature, we anticipate that the level of funding for each district for Low Income Day Care programs will be the lesser of your current fiscal year expenditures or current allocation.
